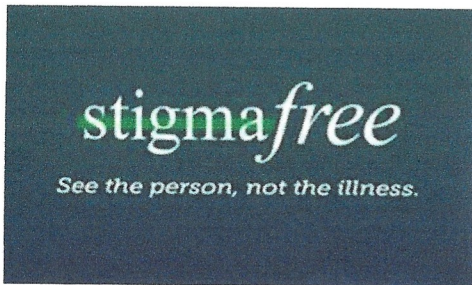




A Message From Our Executive Director
