Christmas Eve food for a delicious dinner was donated by Zachry Corporation. Music was provided during the season by the NFA Choir, and two local musicians came and played music and sang for a joyous evening, thanks to Carol Whitham.

We are preparing to tackle the massive task of replacing carpeting with tiles. As you remember we received a grant from the State of Connecticut, Office of Policy and Management to do this project. As residents have moved out or changed rooms we have been able to make a small dent in the project but now we will be moving full steam ahead to complete the project before 7/1/20. One complication is that we are once again without a custodial/maintenance person. We are actively seeking a replacement for this vacancy.
